Thought leaders Tobin and Goldberg will debate critical issues concerning the State of Israel. Is partition into two states the way to ensure Israel's survival or a path to continuing strife?" Tobin and Goldberg's statements partly articulate debating points and partly lessons to teach the audience to listen to the 'other' and to genuinely consider the possibility that there are other legitimate opinions to be heard. This touring debate of "spirited civil disagreement may trigger a certain degree of distress, but is also healthy both for American democracy and the Jewish World," states Tobin in an editorial piece in JNS.ORG (Jewish News Service).

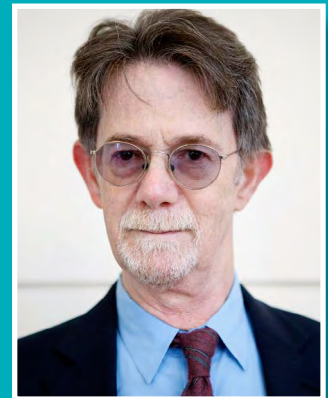
